

Summer Reading Requirements for Students Entering Third Grade

Number of Pages: 200 to 400

Assessment: Record reading data on the Berean Academy Reading Log (due

the first day of school)

Non-Fiction: It is highly recommended that at least two selections be non-

fiction. The current reading list does not include non-fiction titles, so parents will need to choose age appropriate non-fiction

selections for their children.

Read Alouds: An adult may read aloud up to 125 pages to the child, as long as

the selections are at least fifth-grade level.

New Students: Students new to Berean Academy who enroll after July 15 will

have their number of pages reduced to 100. New students who enroll close to the first day of school may have an alternative set of guidelines established by the administration or faculty.
